29th Avenue Overpass to Receive Much Deserved Attention Road Closure April 23, 24 and 25, 2007

Oakland, CA — The City of Oakland Public Works Agency is slated to work on the 29th Avenue Overpass on Monday, April 23, 2007. The road will be closed and a detour set up for the duration of the much deserved project on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday April 23, 24 and 25, 2007 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. each day. During work hours the overpass will be closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic. The detour will route traffic along 23rd Avenue.

Project signage was posted starting April 13, 2007 to alert the community to the upcoming project, and will continue through completion of the project. Detour signs and routes will be posted during construction hours. Crews will be milling and paving the roadways to upgrade the overpass.
